Qualifications

- Ph.D. degree in Music Therapy.
- Demonstrated ability to supervise master's theses or research projects.
- Administrative capabilities in research projects, conferences, or workshops.
- Proficiency in Chinese communication, with the ability to teach in both Chinese and English.

- (7) Original passport entry/exit records covering the study period (as required by Taiwan's Ministry of Education for foreign degree recognition)
- (8) Teacher qualification certificate issued by the Ministry of Education (if applicable)
- (9) Other relevant certificates

2. Scholarly Publications

- (1) Doctoral dissertation or academic works published after obtaining the current rank.
- (2) List of related publications and two representative reprints.

3. **Teaching Plans**

- (1) Select two master's-level courses and two undergraduate-level courses from the following list and provide detailed teaching plans for each, including teaching objectives.
- (2) A sample Course Plan of Tunghai University is provided in the attachment.

Graduate-level Courses:

- Research in Music Therapy
- Music Learning Theory & Music Teaching Methods
- Theory and Evidence-Based Approach for Music Therapy
- Application of Music Therapy for Communication Disorders

Undergraduate-level Courses:

- Clinical Improvisation Skills for Individual & Group Treatments
- Observation and Measurement for Music Behaviors
- Psychology of Music
- Music Therapy for Elderly

(Each course carries 2 credits and is a required semester course.)

4. **Teaching Demonstration Video**

A 30–40 minute video featuring a self-designed lecture or demonstration on a selected topic.

5. **Two Letters of Recommendation**

Letters should be sent directly by referees to the Department of Music via email (PDF).

6. **Copy of Professional Certification** related to Music Therapy (if applicable).

7. **Additional Supporting Documents** (optional but encouraged).

Employment Information

- Appointment follows Tunghai University's regulations for full-time faculty.
- Initial appointment: 1 year; first reappointment: 1 year; subsequent reappointments: 2 years each.
- Standard teaching load: 9 hours per week (may be reduced for administrative duties).
- Faculty members may apply for a 4-day work week with approval if it benefits university operations.
- External part-time teaching or employment requires prior written approval; external teaching limited to 2 hours per week.

- Reappointment is contingent upon evaluation of teaching, service, and advising performance.
- Salary will be determined according to Tunghai University's salary regulations for faculty.
